This Weeks Highlights

Apples, apples, apples!



This week we are going to be reading several books about apples. We will also read about Johnny Appleseed and do a few apple crafts.

Bible: We will continue our study of Genesis. We will read about Noah. Memory verse assessment on Friday. **Phonics**: We will learn the phonograms /ee/ and /ng/. We will also learn the following R blends: br, cr, dr, fr, gr, pr, tr, str, wr. Quiz on Friday over the following: /ee/; /ng/; /y/; /br/; /cr/; /dr/; /fr/; /gr/; /pr/ and /tr/.

Penmanship: We will learn the correct formation of the following cursive letters: n, A, h, and r. We will review the letters we have learned and begin joining them together to make blends and words.

Grammar: We will learn the "Sentence Jingle", the "Noun Jingle" and the "Verb Jingle".

Math: We will learn the following: comparing and ordering objects by size; adding 0 and adding 1; identifying and acting out "some, some went away" stories; identifying the time one hour ago and one hour from now; and numbering a clockface. Our first timed fact assessment will be Tuesday over the doubles facts.

History: We will learn about the Idaho State Capitol.


